DAILY RESORT ACTIVITIES

Shuttle Service: Shuttle service is available daily from 8:30am-5:00pm. Avoid headaches and long walks - use our door-to-door shuttle service to Lutsen Mountains Ski Area. Make arrangements at the front desk or dial 0 to schedule a pick up.

Complimentary Cross Country Ski Equipment: Cross country ski equipment is available at the front desk for guest use. Adult and children sizes available. Please check out equipment only when you are using it. Please do not keep cross country ski equipment in your rooms, as other guests may be waiting to use it. Trail maps are available at the front desk. The cross country ski trails are maintained by the state of Minnesota. **A Minnesota Ski Pass is required for anyone age 16 or older.** The Ski Pass can be purchased online at www.dnr.state.mn.us or from Clearview General Store located one mile north of the main lodge on Highway 61; \$6/ day pass and \$20/season pass. (This is similar to a fishing or hunting license.) This pass applies to all public cross country ski trails in the state of Minnesota.

Complimentary Snowshoe Equipment: Snowshoes are available at the front desk for guest use. Adult and children sizes available. Please check out equipment only when you are using it. Trail maps are available at the front desk. Please do not snowshoe on groomed ski trails.

Weather Forecast and Trail Conditions: The current weather forecast and trail conditions can be found on the activities bulletin boards at the Main Lodge and at the Sea Villas. Get up-to-date weather information from the Activities Desk computer station. Weather along the north shore can change quickly, dress appropriately!

Area Activity Information and Trail Maps: Stop by the activities desk for more information on area activities, brochures and trail maps. Some of the most helpful brochures you will find there are the "Nearby Snowshoe Hikes" brochure, and the "Shopping and Dining Guide, Grand Marais Minnesota." The Activities Staff and Front Desk Staff are available to help answer any of your questions.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

Guided Snowshoe Hike: Always wanted to try snowshoeing? Here's your chance! Meet in the Main Lodge lobby. Our staff outfits you with a pair of snowshoes and shows you how to adjust them. We take a shuttle to a nearby trail for a relaxed hike through the winter woods. With a little luck, we may spot some wildlife! No experience necessary. *Reserve your spot up to 1 week before each activity.*

Night Hike: Darkness settles in early this time of year but that doesn't mean we have to stay inside. Join us for a guided tour through the night where we'll look for a bright starry sky. Depending on conditions, we'll either strap on snowshoes or just tromp in winter boots. *Sign up with the Activities staff starting 1 week before.* Meet at the Activities desk dressed for the weather at 6pm. Relax by the lobby fireplace when we get back.

Cross Country Ski Tour: Dress warm and meet in the Main Lodge lobby. Our staff outfits you with cross country skis, boots and poles. *You are required to provide a Minnesota Cross Country Ski Pass.* We take a shuttle to a nearby trail and get a brief introduction to using the equipment. From there, we start skiing and take our time to enjoy the winter woods while becoming more comfortable on the skis. Beginner skiers welcome. *Reserve your spot up to 1 week before each activity.*

Lobby Craft: Let the beauty of nature inspire your craftiness! This is a fun activity for all ages; it usually takes about 15 minutes and is conveniently located at the main lodge. We will make candles, soaps, bird houses or other interesting items.

Live Music: The North Shore is blessed with a multitude of musicians and we are happy to share their talents with you. Their melodies can be enjoyed in the Lobby or the Poplar River Pub.
