

## LAKES

*Caribou Lake* – **Access:** Gravel ramp and parking area on west side of lake off County Road 4. Parking available. **Species:** Northern Pike, Bass, Walleye, White Sucker, Yellow Perch

*Deer Yard Lake* – **Access:** South shore of SW end of lake. 125 ft carry-in trail from small parking area at end of new forest road off Caribou Trail 4. **Species:** Golden shiner, White Sucker, Walleye

*Christine Lake* – **Access:** Gravel ramp in Sec. 29, with parking. Access at end of rough road off F.R. 164. **Species:** Bluegill, Northern Pike, Pumpkinseed Sunfish, Walleye, White Sucker, Yellow Perch

*Tait Lake* – **Access:** On SW shore, off Forest Road 340. Parking available. **Species:** Bluegill, Northern Pike, Pumpkinseed Sunfish, Walleye

*Holly Lake* – **Access:** Located in Sec. 10, on the SE shore of the lake, off County Road 4. **Species:** Northern Pike, Pumpkinseed Sunfish, Walleye, White Sucker, Yellow Perch

*Lake Clara* – **Access:** Gravel ramp and parking area off F.R. 339, 3 mi W of the Caribou Trail. **Species:** Northern Pike, Pumpkinseed Sunfish, Walleye, White Sucker, Yellow Perch

*White Pine Lake* – **Access:** Concrete ramp at south end of the lake, with parking. **Species:** Bluegill, Northern Pike, Pumpkinseed Sunfish, Walleye, White Sucker, Yellow Perch

*Bigsby Lake* – **Access:** Public access on Caribou Lake, access to Bigsby Lake via navigable (but shallow, rocky, and weedy) channel. **Species:** Northern Pike, Smallmouth Bass, Yellow Perch

*Pike Lake* – **Access:** Gravel launch area on the east end of the lake, off County Road 45. Road-side parking for three vehicles. Poor, shallow launch area. **Species:** Lake Whitefish, Northern Pike, Smallmouth Bass, Walleye, Yellow Perch, White Sucker
